SOAR Fox Cities is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization that works with people with developmental disabilities and those who have been impacted by Traumatic Brain Injuries.

WHAT WE DO

ADULT SERVICES

Social, Recreation, and Respite (SRR)

A wide variety of educational, cultural, and recreational activities year-round that develop self-esteem and social skills, and increase community involvement.

Adult Education

Educational sessions on a wide variety of topics such as health and wellness, self-care, safety, finances, healthy relationships, and independent living.

ADVOCACY

People First Fox Cities

A self-advocacy group that encourages and trains individuals to speak up and advocate for themselves.

Individual Advocacy Support

Information and connections to community resources.

TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY SUPPORT

Education, Connection, and Support

Support group meetings, resource navigation, case management, and community outreach provide information and support to those who have been impacted by a brain injury.

COMMUNITY EDUCATION

Adult Presentations

Training sessions and presentations that raise awareness on disability-related topics such as employment, creating inclusive environments, sensitivity and etiquette, and respectful language.

Youth Presentations

Provide disability and diversity awareness to youth through the use of Kids on the Block puppets (elementary school) and interactive presentations (middle and high school).

YOUTH PROGRAMS

Kidz Club and Teen Stop

After-school programs for youth with and without disabilities at local elementary and middle schools.

Teens and Transitioning Youth

Activities that foster understanding, inclusion, and acceptance among youth with and without disabilities (ages 13-23.)

SOAR Thru Summer Camp

Daily summer camp for youth entering 6th grade through age 17.

Collaborative School Programming

SOAR staff provide educational, social, and recreational activities during the school day.

SPECIAL OLYMPICS

Bowling, Basketball, Aquatics, Track & Field, Softball, Tee-Ball, and Bocce

As the third largest Special Olympics agency in the state, SOAR provides seven recreational and competitive sports.

CAMPS

Onaway, Adult Fall Weekend

Provide opportunities to learn social and life skills while enjoying classic camp experiences.

FAMILY SERVICES

Social Activities

Fun and welcoming experiences offer families opportunities to network and socialize.

Educational Offerings

Provide information and community resources to parents, family members, and professionals through an annual conference and sessions with speakers.

Support Groups

Parents and caregivers can share questions, joys, concerns, and learn about resources.

AGING AND IDD

A Partnership between SOAR Fox Cities and Fox Valley Memory Project focused on bringing more resources and support to individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities as they age along with their care partners.

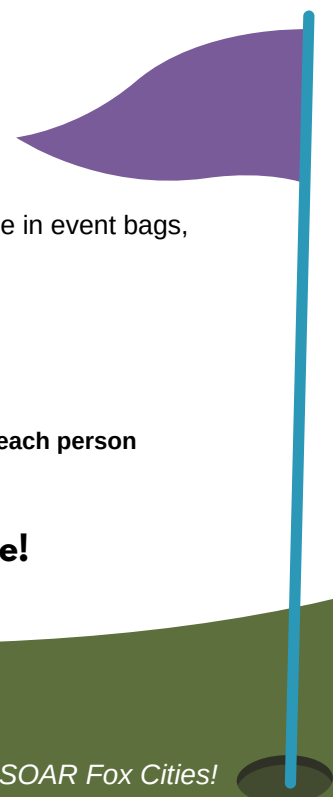
